Non-Invasive Prenatal Testing (NIPT) - Self Pay

Nova Scotia care providers have identified a need for additional information and guidance with assisting pregnant persons who choose non-invasive prenatal testing (NIPT). The following information has been provided as a measure to meet this need.

Please note: the information related to sample collection locations is applicable only to the <u>Dynacare</u> vendor and is accurate as of the date on this document / date posted to the RCP website. Additional locations are evolving and are being added over time. Care providers are encouraged to contact the specific vendor for additional details regarding sample collection locations.

It is recommended that all pregnant persons are offered the option to accept or decline screening for fetal aneuploidy¹. There are currently two tests available for aneuploidy screening: *Maternal Serum Testing (MST)* and *Non-Invasive Prenatal Testing (NIPT)*.

- 1. **MST** is funded by provincial health insurance and consists of two blood tests- the first between 9-13w6d and the second between 15w-20w6d. If the patient misses the first trimester window, the second trimester draw can still be ordered.

- 2. *NIPT* evaluates fetal DNA in maternal circulation and can be done as early as 10 weeks gestation. It is self-pay unless a patient qualifies for a provincially funded test. In addition to providing an assessment of aneuploidy risk, it can also screen for sex chromosome variations and microdeletions. NIPT is provided by independent companies.

Who qualifies for a provincially funded NIPT?

Pregnant persons in Nova Scotia will be offered funded NIPT under the following circumstances:

- A previous pregnancy affected with Trisomy 13, 18 or 21 (in the first trimester, as early as 10 weeks gestation). This is in lieu of standard screening using the MST and nuchal translucency assessments. To access funded NIPT, <u>these patients must be referred to Medical Genetics or a Maternal-Fetal</u> <u>Medicine Specialist</u>.
- 2. Standard screening has found a person to be at **increased risk** of Down Syndrome. Based on the results of standard screening, the individual will be seen by either Medical Genetics or by a Maternal-Fetal Medicine Specialist and will be offered the option of funded NIPT in lieu of diagnostic testing (CVS or amniocentesis). A referral is not necessary.
