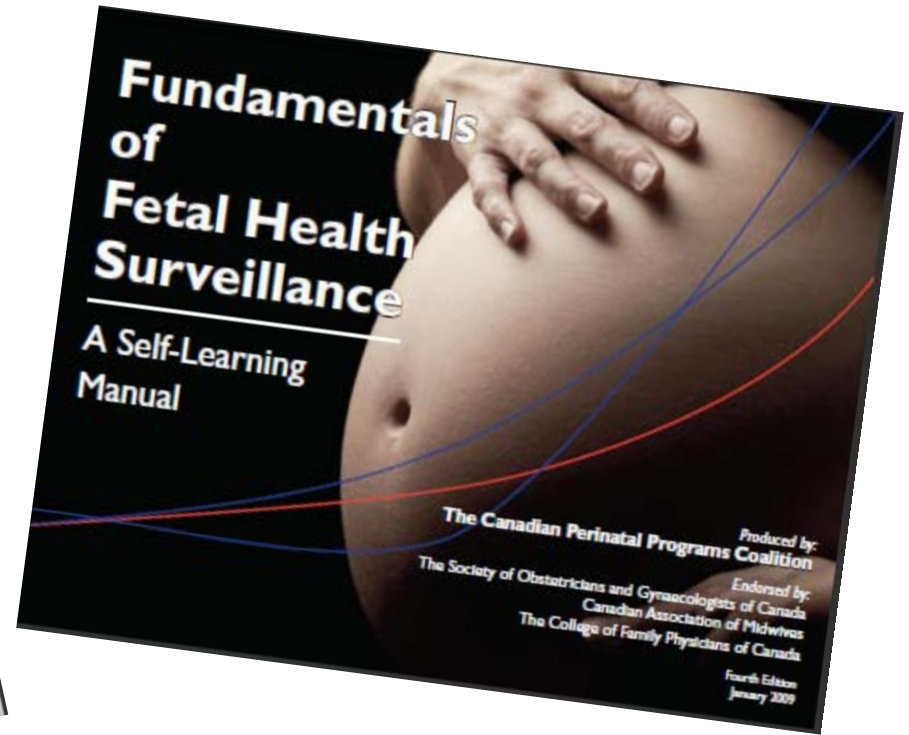
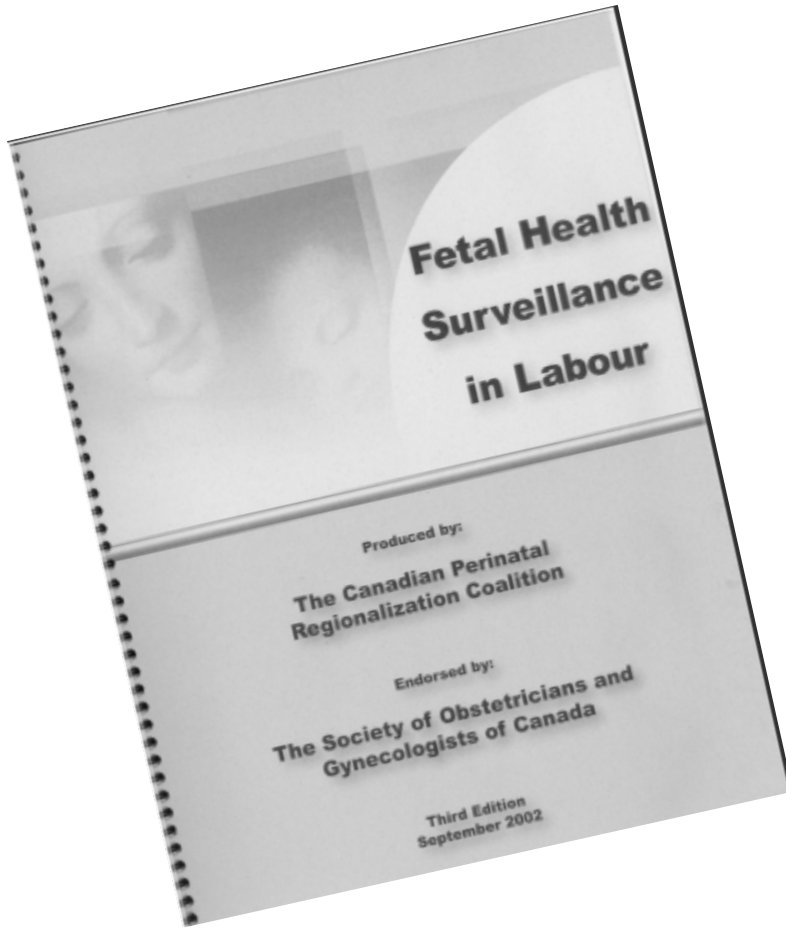

Historical Timelines

- 2008 – release of SOGC guideline in 2007 prompted a revision to the 2002 manual. Desire for a national FHS committee explored.
- 2009 – meetings held to develop a grant proposal to secure funding for a web-based program.
- 2010 – discussion with SOGC and CPPC about a web-based fetal health surveillance program.

Historical Timelines

- 2012 – CPPC requested an update from SOGC as no further information given since June 2010. National FHS survey distributed to instructors.
- 2013 – Survey results favoured an on-line manual but participants still really valued face to face interdisciplinary interaction. Perinatal Services BC had funding to do this project and CPPC supported so we proceeded.
